

## ***MASTER PERSONAL EQUIPMENT LIST***

Equipment lists will be published for each campout, with specific gear for the season/activity in mind. Please ensure that all items outlined in the gear list are included in your gear - Remember - "*A Scout is Prepared*".

All gear should be clearly labeled with the Scout's name!

The following can be used as a general guide:

- Frame back pack, proper size and fitted. Light weight for hiking/pack-ins.
- Sleeping bag (rated 20F is recommended)
- Ground pad
- Flashlight (with extra batteries/bulb)
- Pocket Knife - "Totin Chit" required
- Waterproof matches/fire starter
- Personal First Aid Kit - See the Boy Scout Handbook
- Water bottle/canteen
- Quality compass
- Personal Medications (please hand to leader in original bottle)
- Scout Handbook
- Class "A" Uniform (Wear when traveling, ceremonies, etc.)
- Class "B" Uniform (for activities)
- Waterproof hiking boots
- Hat or cap
- Rain gear or poncho
- Windbreaker or light jacket (adjust for season)
- Extra pair of shoes
- Extra change of clothes (at least one set. Must be something other than cotton)
- Insect repellent (no aerosol spray!)
- Underwear
- Extra BSA socks
- Sweatshirt/jacket
- Mess kit (plate, bowl, cup, fork, spoon, and knife)

- Toiletries kit (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, washcloth, towel, comb)
- Tent & Ground cloth (lightweight, 2-person tent is recommended)
- Camp chair (optional)
- Camera (optional)

For winter camping also bring

- Long Johns
- One to two layers of polar fleece or similar
- Jacket or shell
- Wool or synthetic socks
- Hats (one specifically for sleeping)
- Gloves
- Extra change of all of the above
- Boots (not leather and approved by the scoutmaster)

Don't Bring:

- Video Games \*
- MP3 players/iPod \*
- Mobile phone \*
- Fireworks
- Valuables

\* Exceptions may be made for use of these items while in the vehicle for long trips; these exceptions will be outlined by the Scoutmaster before the trip. Responsibility for the loss of these items will be the Scout's.

The Scoutmaster or Assistant Scoutmasters reserve the right to confiscate any item that is deemed inappropriate. The item in question will be returned to the Scout's parents.
